

## REGISTRATION FORM FOR IGCSE CANDIDATES

**I fully understand and accept the following terms and conditions:**

- In order to be admitted into the IG class, my child must have at least 92% in core subjects (English, Maths and Sciences) and write a mandatory placement test in the first week of resumption.
- My child shall take all subjects offered in the IGCSE program from grade 9 through end of first semester in grade 10.
- There shall be a mock test written at the end of grade 9. This test shall contain all relevant topics studied throughout grade 9 in each subject.
- By grade 10 second semester, my child shall choose preferred relevant subjects to write in the board exam.
- The choice of subject will only be approved based on at least 90% (with or without markup) of grade 9 mock test and grade 10 semester one results written by my child.
- If my child's performance is not above 89% (without the curve up) within the first semester of grade 9, the school will make an autonomous decision to drop my child from the IGCSE program in order to maintain his/her CGPA.
- In order to help improve my child's university application chances according to the requirements of the Ministry of Education, there will be a curve-up grading system (for the IGCSE students **only**) to upgrade marks. This however, does not guarantee that a very poor mark will be significantly improved.
- The IGCSE students leave school at 2:30 or any equivalent of taking 6 periods daily.
- In a case where the IGCSE class is overfilled, the class shall be split into two focus groups and distributed into two classes. The school authority has all the rights to place students in the most appropriate focus groups. This will enable the students to learn more proficiently in a conducive learning environment.
- My child will not be able to transfer from the IGCSE program after 2 weeks of joining.
- If my child wishes to drop the IGCSE program, the school does not guarantee an immediate

placement in a NON-IGCSE class. However, my child will continue to take classes with the IGCSE students but will write the normal school internal exams and other assessments as a NON-IGCSE candidate.

- In case of subjects where the IGCSE and NON-IGCSE syllabi are different (e.g. Arabic), the students will take exams (*whether IG or NON-IG syllabus*) of classes they have been attending.
- Registration will be confirmed after the required non-refundable payment is made (50% of the total IGCSE fees)
- Joining the IGCSE class is subject to availability. The school cannot guarantee a seat after the submission deadline.
- The deadline for the submission of this form is by June 27, 2021.
- The IGCSE fees is not a part of the school fees.
