## A. Grading System (Grades 6 - 12)

IB \& IG students receive an additional report reflecting their actual performance in the respective program.

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## Curve up equation

For grade $\mathbf{1 0}$ IGCSE students, the curve-up is applied for the end-of-term exam and monthly tests and is calculated as follows:

The assessment policy quantifies the level of performance of IG students by transmuting their mark to its percentage and then converting it to the grade component mark.

Percentile $=($ Raw Mark/Total Mark) $\times 50+50$
Curved Up Mark $=($ Percentile $/ 100) \times 30$

## B. Grading system for Grades 11 and 12

## IB students

For grade $\mathbf{1 1}$ IB students, the curve-up is applied for the end-of-term exam and quizzes and it is calculated as follows:

## $>$ Pass \& Failure Policy

In all grade levels, the student shall get the passing mark in each subject at the end of the year, after calculating the average of the three term marks.

## $>$ Re-sit Policy

Grades 6-12: The Re-Sit Exams for grades $\mathbf{6}$ to 12 are conducted at the end of the academic year based on the average grade of the three terms (The End-of-year Result).

## > Promotion policy

- If the student is promoted with 1 subject, he/she shall be assigned an IEP (Individual Education Plan) to work on during the summer holidays.
- The student and his / her guardian have to sign an undertaking to fulfill all the requirements of the IEP.


## D. Criteria for Distinction and Outstanding Awards

## Grades 6-12

- "Distinction Award" is assigned to the students who have scored 93\%-96\% in the core subjects.
- "High Distinction Award" is assigned to the students who have scored an $97 \%$ and above in the core subjects.

Good behavior \& regular attendance are PREREQUISITES for being awarded.

## E. The Credit System \& GPA

Credits are assigned according to the number of periods taken in each subject as shown in the table below:
